Pinnacle Scholarship Application for High School Seniors

The Pinnacle Scholarship Fund was established by Fuel True: Independent Energy & Convenience for the purpose of awarding scholarships to deserving students from within the industry.

Eligibility

Each scholarship recipient must be one of the following:

- child or grandchild of a Fuel True member;
- child of a full-time employee of a Fuel True member; or
- employee of a Fuel True member.

Applicant must be at least 17 years-old.

Applicant must be a current high school senior, have graduated from an accredited high school or have attained the equivalency of a high school diploma.

Applicant will be enrolled in a Kansas college or university as a full-time (12 hours minimum) student for the fall semester of 2024.

Awards

A total of three \$2,000 scholarships will be available for either high school, college or technical school students for 2024. Each recipient will receive \$1,000 per semester (second semester award is contingent upon achieving a first semester grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale as reported by the college's financial aid office). Awards are not automatically renewable. Recipient may reapply for the Pinnacle Scholarship for the second year contingent upon fulfillment of selection criteria, including a GPA of no lower than 2.5 cumulative on a 4.0 scale. (Note: a separate application form is required for a college student reapplying for the Pinnacle Scholarship.)

Application

Each applicant must complete the Pinnacle Scholarship Application and return it along with a current **OFFICIAL** transcript of grades, photocopy of ACT or SAT scores if not included on transcript, 500-word typewritten letter outlining educational and/or career objectives, letter of recommendation from school administrator (or counselor) and letter of recommendation from Fuel True member.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a selection committee consisting of one Fuel True member who is not a director and who is not related to any applicant, one college or university professor and one business man or woman not affiliated with the petroleum marketing industry in Kansas.

Selection committee will conduct a careful review of each applicant's academic standing, school and community service, 500-word essay of educational goal and/or objectives, ACT or SAT scores and personal references.

Payment of Scholarships

Checks will be mailed to recipient's home address and will be made payable jointly to the recipient and the school and must be endorsed by both.

Applications for 2024 Pinnacle Scholarships must be postmarked no later than February 28, 2024. Recipients will be notified by April 1, 2024. Check for the fall semester 2024 will be mailed to recipients prior to beginning of the fall semester.

- Applicant's Official High School Transcript (9th grade through current semester)
- Applicant's ACT or SAT Scores (photocopy if not included on transcript)
- Letter of Recommendation from School Administrator or Employer
- Letter or Recommendation from Fuel True Member
- Applicant's Letter
